Introduction to the municipality

Rubí is a Catalan municipality with a history stretching back more than a thousand years. With over 80,000 inhabitants, it's the fourth-largest city in the Vallès Occidental region. Rubí lies 23 kilometres away from Barcelona, with Terrassa and Sant Quirze del Vallès to the north, Ullastrell to the west, Sant Cugat to the east and Castellbisbal to the south.

Rubí is a strategic communications hub and one of the most important centres of economic activity in Catalonia. In fact, it has more industry than any other city in Catalonia except Barcelona.

According to historians, the name of our city comes from the Latin Rivo Rubeo, found in Roman remains. This translates to 'red river', and refers to the reddish clay carried by the waters of the Riera de Rubí.

Today, Rubí is made up of 25 neighbourhoods. 13.65% of its inhabitants have come here from other parts of the world, especially Morocco, and we also have a significant number of neighbours of Latin American origin. Although these may be our two largest immigrant communities, there are many more: our city has become a great example of diversity and social wealth that is a part of our heritage and a great source of pride.

Thank you for choosing Rubí as a place to live and let your life unfold.

Administrative procedures

Citizen Service Office (OAC)

The OAC's job is to help give citizens the information they need and to help them with any administrative processes, petitions and suggestions in their interactions with the Administration.

Registering as a resident

The population register

The population register (padró) is a list of everyone who lives in the municipality. You can register for free, and this will allow you to certify that you live in Rubí. You will need to register and certify your status as a resident to access the different public services (schools, healthcare services, etc.).

Registering as a resident is everyone's right and obligation, no matter their citizenship or legal and administrative status (in other words, whether or not they have a residency permit).

Non-EU foreign nationals without a permanent residency permit must renew their registration as a resident every two years. If they fail to do so, their registration will expire and they will be automatically removed from the register.



Legal immigration advice

Legal advisory service on immigration matters in Rubí (SAJ)

This is a free service that provides legal advice on matters regarding immigration with the goal of regularizing the administrative status of the city's immigrant population.

What does it offer?

Advice and assistance on the different means of regularizing your administrative status according to both national and regional law.

Who is it for?

Foreign individuals registered as residents of Rubí.

Where should you go?

To the group information sessions on immigration (two sessions per month) held in the Rubí Forma building on Rambleta de Joan Miró, s/n. Admission is free until capacity is reached.

Social integration and family reunification

Service for preparing proposals for immigration reports

SOCIAL INTEGRATION

INF02: SOCIAL INTEGRATION REPORT

What is it?

A document that states how long a person has been living in Spain, their family ties, their livelihood, or the training and integration programs they have completed to show their level of integration into their host society.

Who is it for?

Non-EU foreigners aged 18 or above who are registered as residents in Rubí, who find themselves in an irregular administrative status at the time of application, and who can prove they have resided in Spain for at least three years.

There are some exceptions, as indicated in document SIMC/TSF/1/2017.

What is it for?

To regularize the individual's administrative status so they can obtain a residency permit or a residency and work permit.

INF03: REPORT FOR THE RENEWAL/MODIFICATION OF TEMPORARY RESIDENCY BASED ON SOCIAL INTEGRATION

What is it?

An overall assessment of the integration efforts an individual has made during their time in the country.

What is it for?

It is necessary for renewing temporary residency and work authorizations.

**Who is it for?**

Non-EU foreigners who are registered as residents in Rubí and who need to renew or modify their temporary residency permit because they do not currently meet one of the requirements for renewal.

FAMILY REUNIFICATION**INF01: HOUSING ADEQUACY REPORT FOR FAMILY REUNIFICATION****What is it?**

A report certifying that an individual has adequate housing that meets habitability conditions.

What is it for?

The housing adequacy report is necessary for requesting family reunification.

Who is it for?

Non-EU foreigners aged 18 or above who have a residency permit that had been renewed or is in the process of being renewed.

INF04: HOUSING ADEQUACY REPORT FOR RENEWING RESIDENCY FOR FAMILY REUNIFICATION**What is it?**

A report certifying that an individual has adequate housing that meets habitability conditions.

What is it for?

To renew residency permits for family reunification when an individual has changed their address from the original place of reunification.

Who is it for?

Non-EU foreigners aged 18 or above who have a residency permit that has been renewed and who have changed their place of residence from the one documented at the time of reunification.

Where should you go to request immigration papers?

Citizen Service Office (OAC)

All reports should be requested by submitting an official request (instància) either through the OAC or the website of the City Council. Attach the corresponding petition and any necessary documents.

You can file a complaint with the Ombudsman regarding the actions of the Rubí City Council and the public entities it is responsible for. Any individuals or organizations that address the Ombudsman should first have filed a complaint with the City Council in the form of an official request (instància), notice, objection or suggestion.

Equal treatment and non-discrimination

Office for Equal Treatment and Non-Discrimination of the Government of Catalonia

The Office of Equal Treatment and Non-Discrimination acts in cases of discrimination due to age, origin, sex or gender, LGBTI-phobia, language or cultural identity, religious beliefs, social or economic condition, administrative status, aporophobia, physical disability, sensory disability or other types of disability, health conditions, serological status or origin. It also addresses all forms of specific racism, such as discrimination against Romani individuals or antisemitism.

Health

Individual Health Card (TSI)

This document gives you access to public health centres and services, and must be presented at pharmacies to receive medications financed by the Catalan Health Service.

This card is free, personal and non-transferable, and each member of a family must have their own.

Requirement: the person must be registered as a resident of a municipality in Catalonia.

What documentation is required when applying for a TSI?

You must bring your personal identification (DNI, passport or NIE and, in the case of minors, family book [llibre de família]).

Where should you go to apply?

To the Primary Care Centre (CAP) assigned to your place of residence.

CAP (Primary Care Centre)

The CAP is a public service for all citizens of Catalonia. The professionals dedicated to primary care can address most health problems. They also handle emergencies and assign reference professionals.





Education

Municipal Education Service

This service manages our municipal educational policy and works to ensure that the educational services offered meet the needs of our inhabitants. It is in charge of municipal schools and any educational matters the City Council is responsible for.

Education is a right. It is compulsory and free of charge for all children aged 6 to 16.

It is divided into two stages: primary education and obligatory secondary education (ESO).

- 6-12 years old: primary school.
- 12-16 years old: secondary school.

There are also educational options for children aged 0 to 3 and for those 16 or older.

NON-COMPULSORY STAGE

Early childhood education

Children aged 0 to 3.

Nursery schools are social and educational centres for children from 4 months to 3 years old. This period is recognized as a stage within the education system, but it is not compulsory. Rubí has both public and private nursery schools.

EDUCATION FOR YOUNG PEOPLE OLDER THAN 16

Individual, personalized attention is offered based on your circumstances.

Graduate in Secondary Education (GES)

This is the title students are given once they have completed compulsory secondary education (ESO). It allows them to access baccalaureate studies, intermediate vocational training, education in sports, education in arts and design, or the workforce.

Certificate of Secondary Schooling

If the student does not complete ESO, they are given this title. It allows them to access vocational training and employment integration programs (PFI), language courses, and elementary and professional studies in music and dance.

To move on to post-compulsory secondary education you must first attend school for adults, occupational training, training and insertion programs or a preparatory course for accessing intermediate studies.

Where should you go to apply at an educational centre?

ONGOING EDUCATION FOR ADULTS

Education for adults gives people over the age of 16 an opportunity to access different levels of studies, and it contributes to the ongoing, generalized training of this part of the community. In general, it is accessible to individuals who are 18 years old or who will turn 18 during the calendar year when the course starts.

Mediation

Citizen Mediation Service

This is a free, open space for assisting the public, a space for dialogue where you can receive guidance, orientation and find peaceful, voluntary, impartial and confidential solutions for everyday conflicts.

- Conflicts between neighbours due to things like noise, leaks, hygiene, odours, inconveniences caused by pets, uncivil behaviour, disagreements or misunderstandings.
- Family conflicts: intergenerational relationships, couples, dependent individuals, difficulties with relationships and communication, etc.
- Communication or relational conflicts between individuals.
- Conflicts over the use of public space and the neighbourhood.
- Conflicts among the members of an organization or association, conflicts between associations, etc.
- Conflicts related to economic activities: noise, odours, licenses, matters related to consumption, contractual matters (rental, sale, etc.).




